<b>Summary</b>	<p>The attached document explains the process of moving towards delegated commissioning of primary care, for March 2016.</p> <p>The deadline for submission to NHS England is Friday 2 October 2015. Each CCG in South West London is asked to explore the option to move to individual CCG delegated commissioning, in preparation for a discussion due to take place at September Governing Body meetings. Although we know the required submission date, as yet NHS England is to release detail on the processes required; we expect this will be available as of July 2015.</p>
