<p>Summary of purpose and scope of report</p> <p>This document provides a blueprint for the way that NHS England (London) primary care commissioning and contracting teams will support CCGs which have moved to joint or delegated co-commissioning arrangements. It summarises responsibilities for decision making, reporting required to support decision making, and committee governance, processes and capabilities.</p> <p>Development process</p> <p>The Operating Model has been developed by NHS England (London), with extensive consultation with CCGs and SPGs through the Co-Commissioning Next Steps Working Group, chaired by David Sturgeon. The draft presented reflects the consensus of feedback of the Next Steps group. We have now received and incorporated final comments and the version of the operating model that is tabled represents the final draft, for approval.</p> <p>Future Changes</p> <p>It is proposed that if any further changes are required, that these are developed collaboratively, through the Co-Commissioning Next Steps group, and that these are approved, under change control, and following the process outlined below.</p> <p>Document approval</p> <p>The document has been sent to the Chief Officer of each CCG for approval. For NHS England, it was approved by Simon Weldon, Director of Operations and Delivery, on 24 September 2015.</p> <p>RECOMMENDATIONS: The Joint Committee are asked to approve the document.</p>
