Summary of purpose and scope of report

This forum met for the second time on 12.10.20105. The Terms of Reference and membership for this forum were approved. Key points for discussion included:

- Feedback from 8th September Estates Workshop generally a positive workshop and the overall feedback was that CCGs need to continue to engage with providers at a local level for individual local estates strategy, which can be pulled together to form part of the SWL Estates Strategy.
- CCGs provided updates on their strategy plans each CCG provided their current position of where they are in putting together their local strategy.
- It was agreed that six plans will be submitted by the end of December 2015.
- The role of this group is that of an oversight and the aim is to have one SWL strategy by March 2016.
- The forum will bring a few slides answering a set of questions indicating each CCGs position on drafting its local estates strategy to the next forum scheduled for 24.11.2015.
- Feedback from the London Estates Group a London virtual group will be set up to help engagement and communication about the estates strategy with the local authority.
