# SWL PMS Commissioning Intentions

- All SWL CCGs were asked to complete a template on PMS commissioning intentions and submit to NHSE London region by/on the 19 February 2016.
- The following slides provide a summary of the SWL CCGs template responses. It should be noted that these are commissioning intentions and are therefore subject to further discussion and financial modelling to determine the impact on confirming 'new' PMS contracts as of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016.
- The PMS review offers a good opportunity to deliver and embed the Strategic Commissioning Framework (SCF) and the areas identified within the London offer of the PMS are based on the access specifications, in particular of the SCF.



# **SWL PMS Commissioning Intentions**

- All SWL CCGs will offer the mandatory London Standard KPIs
- Of the two 'Patient Voice' KPIs to be offered, most CCGs have opted for 'Overall Experience' and either 'Experience of making an appointment' or 'Convenience of Appointment'
- Of the locally commissioned KPIs, most CCGs will either offer the 'Premium Access Service Specification' or will offer a locally agreed KPI which provides a similar service. Richmond does not plan to offer the 'Premium Access Service Specification'
- Croydon plans to offer the Breast Screening KPI



# **Examples of Other Commissioning Intentions**

#### Croydon

Smoking cessation, dementia, diabetes, CHD, Hypertension, COPD, CVD, Mental Health, Optional Services (Deprivation, Children under 5, Young people 16-24 sexual health and minor injuries), Practice Development and Delivery Scheme (PDDS), stabilisation across GMS/PMS using transition approach, and leg ulcers

#### **Kingston**

Plans for other services in development and dependent on outcome of PMS review

#### Merton

Improved access, deprivation and morbidity, medicines waste management, engagement with CCG/London and national priorities

#### **Richmond**

Contract monitoring will be in place for PMCF and BCF systems resilience is monitored as part of the proposed GP Led Model of Care LCS

#### Sutton

Improved access, Reduce Medicines Waste through Improved Compliance with Repeat Medicine, bowel screening, End of life care, spirometry, booking transport, 24 hour BP, use of the most cost-effective gonadoreline analogue, dementia diagnosis, Prostate Cancer, Diabetes, Safeguarding, Post Operative Wound Care

#### Wandsworth

Current Access LIS, Improving access through use of technology, Planning All Care Together (PACT) Programme, Diabetes, Cardio vascular disease, Coronary Heart Disease, Hypertension, COPD, Smoking Cessation, Mental Health



## Other considerations across SWL

## **Engagement:**

- A range of engagement taken place across SWL CCGs and with key committees, also with LMC and practices to get to this stage of the PMS review
- Engagement with practices will continue during March and NHS England (London) to write to PMS practices to set out local offer no later than 31 March 2016

## Impact assessments:

 CCGs largely unable to consider impact assessment without financial modelling of the impact of the PMS Premium and London offer

#### **Transition:**

 CCGs largely suggesting this is an area for further consideration and work through in the coming weeks

## **Equalisation:**

 CCGs committed to equalisation and a number suggesting a 2-3 year timeline for this


